### **Therapeutic Behavioral On-Site Services (TBOS)**

Intensive therapy to children and their families at school, shelters, foster homes, and/or day care centers in an effort to alleviate emotional, behavioral and mental difficulties, improve the quality of life, and prevent the need for a more intensive, costly and restrictive placement



*We take Medicaid/HMOs, Medicare and Self – Pays. Additionally, we have funds available to serve the uninsured, underinsured and individuals who meet financial eligibility requirements regardless of immigration status*

### **Targeted Case Management Services Children, Adults & Intensive:**

- Linking/referring to community resources
- Community outreach
- Monitoring service delivery for progress evaluation
- Coordination of delivery of services
- Advocacy in legal and academic settings
- Crisis intervention and support
- Arranging and coordinating after care services upon discharge

### **Psychosocial Rehabilitation Group Services:**

- Builds skills for independent living: daily tasks, money management, and community services
- Helps overcome barriers and enhance social skills
- Prepares for work environments, fostering independence
- Supports individuals with severe psychiatric or behavioral challenges

### **Comprehensive Behavioral Health Assessment (CBHA):**

The purpose of the CBHA is to integrate and interpret existing information and provide functional information to decision makers in determining:

- The most appropriate out-of-home placement
- Intervention strategies to accomplish family preservation, re-unification, or re-entry and permanency planning
- Comprehensive service plans and behavior health services when indicated
